



Hathern Parish Council Response to Planning Application P/21/1002/2 – 18A Shepshed Rd

We are aware of the concerns over this planning application from a number of residents on Shepshed Rd. Representatives of the Council have visited the location and spoken to residents in the period prior to the application being published by CBC. We have seen at first hand the property damage caused, as part of the excavations that have already occurred on the site in question, by large vehicles accessing the narrow track that runs alongside No18A and other properties on Shepshed Rd. The Council is of the view that this track is not at all suitable as the primary access route for construction and transport vehicles that will be needed to move materials to and from the site.

We are also aware of other concerns expressed by local residents that have already been brought to the Borough Council's attention, in particular the potential impact on wildlife habitat that is so important to the wider area of green space around this location, and trust that these will be fully considered.
